In loving memory of Walt Hilborn (August 30th, 1930 – March 29th, 2009)

Walt Hilborn was an integral part of the Baton Rouge bowling community and most especially All Star Lanes. His love, knowledge and interest of the sport of bowling have motivated many to exceed in the sport and in life— especially our youth bowlers. We are looking for juniors who can honor Walt’s memory and benefit from the path he has paved.

Qualifications

- Nominee must currently bowl in an All Star Lanes – Baton Rouge bowling league or have done so within the last 12 months of application deadline.
- Nominee must be in 8th-12th grade at the time of application deadline.

Scholarship

- The scholarship will range in the amount of \$250 to \$1000 (based on funds available) to be paid to the school of choice. Funds may be used according to SMART regulations. The scholarship will be awarded to at least one boy and one girl.
- Scholarships funds are available for six years from the date of your high school graduation. The one exception would be if a recipient would enlist in the military, the expiration date is extended by the number of years enlisted.

Procedures

- Nominees must submit a completed application by no later than May 3rd, 2011.
- Nominees must have school verify GPA and turn in copy of report card.
- Nominee must write an essay. (See essay section of application for qualified topics)

Selection Rules

Selection of recipient will be based on bowling involvement, academic standing, leadership qualities and essay submitted.

Applicants will be rated as follows:
